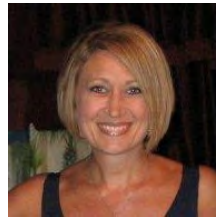

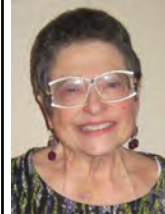

MEET OUR MEMBERS



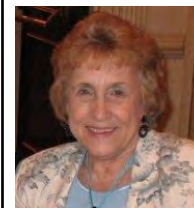
Edith Schulman

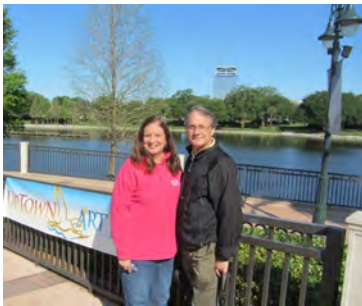
