# 4th Of July Parade

Our decoration (and outfit) contest will be at 9:45, shortly before the parade begins. We are in need of a small panel of judges! Please email us (see below) if you are available.

The parade will kick off at Cedar Pass & Mossy Stone (see the map on page 2 for details). If you would like to watch and admire the parade, you may do so at any point on Cedar Pass between Mossy Stone and Riverview. We do ask that all cars be removed from the parade route. The parade will end at the clubhouse, where refreshing treats will be waiting! The pool will be open for everyone to enjoy throughout the day at your leisure.

#### To maintain a safe parade with both vehicles and bicycles:

- -All cars, motorcycles, trucks, etc will line up on Mossy Stone. Please enter Mossy Stone from Warwickshire, so there is no oncoming traffic where children are gathering (see map).
- -All bicycles, wagons, strollers, scooters, etc will line up on Cedar Pass, on the east side of Mossy Stone (see map).
- -When the parade begins, all vehicles will follow HFD first. Bicycles (and etc) will not join the parade until vehicles have passed.





# 3 ripe avocados 4 ripe tomatoes 1-2 tbsps extra-virgin olive oil

1/4 cup of fresh basil1 tsp of lemon juice

1 garlic clove

salt & pepper



Hello fellow residents, summer is here and temperatures are rising. You may have noticed that the swim team is practicing at our pool, so please watch out for children on bicycles riding through the neighborhood heading for swim practice.

If you are planning on travelling this summer and would like to have the Constable put a vacation watch on your house, please go to the Precinct 5 constable website and download the form. While you are on the website you can look over the other programs that the Constable offers. I took the "Citizens Police Academy". It was extremely informative and enjoyable.

Sadly, crime continues and our lawn and garden contactors and home owners are easy prey for theft of equipment. Please remind them to watch their equipment. During the summer we have many residents enjoying the outdoors and walking the streets of CV, please be observant of your surroundings...if something does not appear right, please call the Constable. The Constable can typically respond in 5-10 minutes, so please call. If you are the victim of a crime please call the Constable, they will respond faster and inform the neighborhood of the crime in a timely manner. HPD does not send out crime alerts, so if you are the victim and HPD responds the only way we would know about it, would be for the victim to pass along the information.
