FIELD TRIP OPPORTUNITY

STUDENT DAY MARCH 23rd, 2018 10am – 5pm

The Alabama Medieval Fantasy Festival invites you and your class to join us for a day especially geared for students and teachers!

We are extending an opportunity for your educational group to purchase discount rate tickets to attend and learn. Our festival is set in a medieval village with historical entertainment, buildings, artisans, guilds, music, food, speech, clothing and merchants. All this for your viewing and educational pleasure (verily, learning can be fun!). Again this year, in order to help school groups attend, our jousters, performers, cast, merchants, staff and volunteers have agreed to help us host student day Friday, for both students and the public to attend. Although your group may certainly decide to attend Saturday or Sunday student pricing is **ONLY** good for Friday and there is an extra emphasis on student-oriented historical demonstrations and activities on Friday. Student pricing (5yrs to 17yrs) is \$5. Other Adults and siblings may also attend at our regular gate price. Almff Inc. reserves the right to deny entry and/or have security/police deal with persons who do any of the following: damage property, harm someone, steal, disrupt scheduled activities etc. Your group will receive one free teacher/chaperone ticket per every 10 students registered every student on Almff grounds **MUST ALWAYS** be accompanied by one responsible adult over the age of 21. Your group must submit a signed dated release form (hold harmless) to the faire, covering **EVERYONE** that will be attending with your group.

The festival opens at 10:00am and closes at 5:00pm daily. Your group may purchase tickets from our website via PayPal (or by check to ALMFF, 7165 Old Pascagoula Rd., Theodore AL 36582) before March 1 2018. All Paperwork including hold harmless waiver must be received before entry.

Food and beverages are available for purchase and may not be brought in; however, we understand if you get “re-entry hand stamps” and plan to eat lunch in the parking area or a nearby restaurant before returning to faire. A map is available at almff.com with information on historical demonstrations and activities scheduled to help your group plan their visit in advance. Demonstrations are scheduled with a time for questions as well as travel time to get from one demo or activity to another. To avoid a bus full of eager young people at one demo site it is advisable to break your group into 10’s plus a chaperone and send each group to a different demo area. It is imperative to set up a rally point for your group in case someone becomes lost or separated (we have a 32 acre site after all). Please note that first aide and a lost child area are under the main gate.

If you or your group wishes to volunteer and become more involved with faire, there may be opportunities to do so. Please, contact us with your ideas on how your group might wish to participate or ask us where we need volunteers.

Some of what your group will get a chance to see:

War horses and knights in full plate armor on our world class Jousts!

They can watch the amazing and educational, world famous, Winged Ambassadors, showcasing medieval falconry and raptor training.

Be bamboozled by the illusions and magic. See a real working Norman encampment, watch how soap and pottery were made, blacksmithing and so much more perhaps they may even see a unicorn, who knows what wonders await. Visit with the King, Queen and court (and maybe catch a peek at a fairy!) Tour our living history areas and chat with Mistress Cook and Master Baker who will show and tell you all about how food and bread were made in 817 AD. And learn how milk goes from the goat to lotion and soap! Most of our merchants have a selection of student priced goods to purchase as well. Learn how swords and knives were made and what peace tie means! Traveling musicians and troubadours will tell the tales of old while you walk the garden path. It will be an experience you and your students will not want to miss. We have a 35 page multi-grade Learning/Curriculum Guide available from our website.

All Students are just \$5. One teacher, Parent or chaperone per 10 children is free. Parents and siblings are welcome at the standard gate prices. Please note that the faire is also open to the public all 3 days.
