

**SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
FEE ORDINANCE
NO. 2019- 74**

**AN ORDINANCE BY MARION TOWNSHIP, CENTRE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THE
PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT REQUIREMENT TO
EMPLOY PERSONNEL FOR ENFORCEMENT OF SAID ACT AND
EMPOWERS TOWNSHIP TO SET APPLICATION FEES AND
CHARGES THEREFOR.**

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to promote the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Marion Township and to conform with the Pennsylvania Sewage Enforcement Act and Regulations to the Act promulgated by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Act requires sewage enforcement officer services within Marion Township.

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act required the employment by the Township of personnel for enforcement of the said Act and empowers the Township to set Application fees and charges therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. The Township elects to use the services of a third party sewage enforcement officer to provide various inspection and enforcement services pertaining to the installation of, maintenance and design related services pertaining to on-lot sewage disposal.
2. The sewage enforcement officer within the Township shall be determined by the governing body of this Township from time to time by resolution.

3. Fees assessable by the third party sewage enforcement officer shall be approved from time to time by the Township by Resolution.

4. This ordinance shall be effective the ___ day of _____, 2019.

5. If any section, subsection, sentence or clause of this Ordinance is held for any reason to be invalid, such decision or decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
