

**Fifth Sunday of Lent
John 12:20-33**

“Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit.”

Most students educated in the United States, and probably many other places in the world, can remember an assignment to plant some seeds in cups and bring them to school when they had leaves or flowers. Today the exercise may include using artificial light or hydroponics with minerals in solution. We learned that a seed cannot remain a seed and be completely productive. It has to grow, and growth involves change. Jesus knew he had to grow and change and that we all need to grow and change. Jesus knew that the time had come for him to endure the consequences of his repeated call for change. It is time for everyone, and that includes us, to recognize the silly, stupid, senseless and sinful behavior in their lives and to GROW - to CHANGE - to be PRODUCTIVE - to become ALL THAT GOD CREATED THEM TO BE. Lent is a time for us to examine our lives to determine if we are Growing, Changing, Producing Good, and Becoming All that God Created Us to Be?
