This is a jackpot rodeo, so everyone will be entered in the jackpot. A portion of your entry fee will go into the jackpot fund.

There will be warm-up/practice barrels and poles for \$5 per run. Time will be posted.

Shoot:

There will be a shoot on Saturday morning at the Livonia Conservation Club, 5853 S Possum Hollow Rd, Campbellsburg, IN 47108. Shooters will meet with Dill Whittymore at the Announcer's Stand at 7:15 am to depart for the range.

Camping/Stalls:

This is a primitive site. There are no electric or water hookups, or shower facilities. There are NO stalls, so you will need to tie to your trailer or set up pens. Each family must clean up their site -- **trash needs to be placed in the dumpster and manure and hay spread out over the ground.**
