Villa Park Elementary won the trophy for top attendance for the month of September from OUSD. The school now has a 96%-97% attendance rate. State test scores were released and VPE is the 5th in the district for top scores for elementary schools. VPE has 74% (meeting or exceeding standards) for Language/Reading and 71% (meeting or exceeding standards) in Math. The goal is to become a California Distinguished School and VPE needs high test scores, low suspension rates, and attendance to earn that award. After school enrichment programs are being finalized. VPE will offer Robotics, Drone Fun, and E-Sports. School is using ELAC stipend to offer

STEM programs to students. CARES is receiving a second trailer and VPE will be permitted to use it for STEM lab.
