LADY MT. LIONS WIN SECTIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP OVER UNION 74-50

HAMBLETON – The Tucker County Girls' Basketball team hosted Union on Thursday April 15th for the Sectional Championship. The Lady Mt. Lions jumped out to an early lead and never looked back in route to a 74-50 victory. Tucker County controlled the game early as they led after one quarter of play 19-8. The Lady Mt. Lions also controlled the second quarter as they outscored the Lady Tigers 21-14 to put the Tucker County lead at 40-22 at the halftime break. Union showed some life in the third as they lost the third by a slim 17-16 margin to make the score 54-38. The Lady Mt. Lions then made a run in the fourth quarter to increase the lead to 68-38 with 5:20 left in the game. The Tucker County reserves then finished the game as the Lady Mt. Lions got the win by the final score of 74-50.

London Hood led Tucker County with 23 points, 6 rebounds, 6 assists, 5 steals and Kadie Colebank added 17 points, 8 rebounds for the Lady Mt. Lions in the win. Macy Helmick reached double figures for Tucker County with 12 points, 5 rebounds, 3 assists and Jacey Davis had 8 points, 4 rebounds off the bench. Gracie Rapp and Brylee Wetzel added 5 points each for the Lady Mt. Lions.

The win gave Tucker County the Sectional Championship and the victory also allows them to host the Co-Regional Final on Wednesday April 21st against Pocahontas County. The winner of the April 21st game will advance to the WV Girls' Basketball State Tournament in Charleston on April 27th.
