(Please read carefully)

HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS:

By February 15, 2018 submit the application form to your high school counselor. The application consists of two sections: personal data and extra-curricular activities. Your counselor will send the completed form, along with your high school transcript, to the Greenwood's Scholarship Foundation. You can also bring your Financial Aid SAR to your counselor and it will be included in your application packet or you can send it directly to the Greenwood's Scholarship Foundation.

COLLEGE STUDENTS:

By February 15, 2018 submit the completed application to:

Also at this time, request an official, up-to-date transcript from your College to be sent to Greenwood's by April 10, 2018. It is important to have a GPA on the transcript. If you have recently transferred and you do not yet have a GPA from your current college, please also send the transcript from your previous college, as well as, the current transcript.

ALL APPLICANTS: high school AND college students MUST submit a **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**. The easiest and fastest way to apply is at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The SAR acknowledgment is immediately available to you on the FAFSA website along with an email with a link to your SAR. Send or fax a copy of **ALL** the SAR pages to Greenwood's.

By April 10, 2018 Greenwood's MUST have received your SAR and transcript. If your packet isn't complete, your application will not be considered. *All financial information is held in strict confidence.*
