

He is good and His love endures forever and His faithfulness is to all generations.

- 1. Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth.
- 2. Worship the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs.
- 3. Know that the LORD is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.
- 4. Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.
- 5. For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations. (Ps, 100:1-5 NIV)
