- Accessing legal, private, personal or confidential information (online banking, government documents, unemployment, etc.)

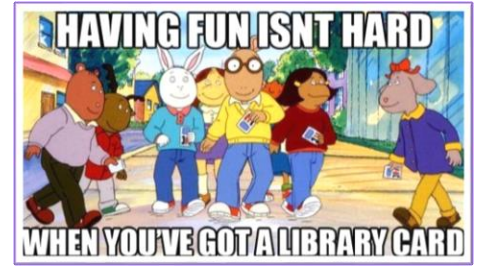
Bringing an assistant or trusted friend may be necessary for you to accomplish your tasks.
