### President's Message

I read an article on Bob Jones Birthday Tribute today. I want to share with you why Golf was Bobby Jones's game..."Golf means fellowship. It bridges the gap of generations. It is the only game I know where a father and a son may meet on exactly an equal basis. Where the good player and a duffer can compete on the same terms. I know I can meet men a hundred times on a business or social footing and never know them; but, once you go out on the golf course with a man and play the game with him, you know him. Golf to me has meant and always will mean a list of real friendships, besides all other successes of life are negligible. Of course it's a great thing in my life; but, the greatest thing in golf is friendship." Bob Jones, circa 1930

I believe that this inherent in the majority of El Prado Men's Golf Club members!

The purpose of the USGS Handicap System is to make the game of Golf more enjoyable by enabling players of differing abilities to compete on an equitable basis. The system provides a fair Course Handicap for each player, regardless of ability, and adjusts a player's Handicap Index up or down as the player's game changes.

Two basic premises underline the USGA Handicap System, namely that each player will try to make the best score at every hole in every round, regardless of where the round is played, and that the player will post every acceptable round for *peer review*. The player and the player's Handicap Committee have joint responsibility for adhering to these premises.

EPMC Handicap committee consists of your board: Fred Wallace (Handicap Chairman), Fred Street, Doug Benc, David Cox, John Kramer, Richard Lizarraga and Mark Rief. We are currently looking at several members that display handicaps that are not consistent with acceptable norms or members where the committee has received complaints from other members including 2 board members (Peer Review).

Other discussions by the board were:

- There is no local rule for relief from the mulch around the tree wells.
- The drop zone on Hole # 7 Chino Creek is at the red tees, not on the mound.

## Tournament News

Member/Member was two days of great golf and good times playing competitive golf with all our friends. We had excellent weather and a very good turnout with 19 (A) teams and 18 (B) teams for a total of 74 players. Congratulations to all the winners.

I would like to write a word or two on the subject of **“good sportsmanship”**. Many of us find ourselves in a set of circumstances where we could help a fellow competitor or just stand by like a “looky-loo” at an accident scene. The following are several situations which come up quite frequently and in each case we can:

- a) Say nothing, knowing it is not our issue.
- b) Purposely don't pay any attention to the details and then jump right in to call the infraction.
- c) Be good sports and try to resolve the issue before there is a problem.

Case #1. In your foursome, someone asks one of the competitors to move his mark on the putting green. After everyone else putts and noticing that the player forgot to put his mark back,

- Remind the player to replace his mark.

Case #2. You are playing in a group and you see that one of the players is about to set up on the wrong tees.

- Inform the player he is on the wrong tee box.

Case #3. After putting out and about to record the scores, someone obviously gives you a wrong score.

- Remind the player of the details you are aware of. Many times this leads to the person saying “oh yeah, thanks for reminding me”.

Case #4. Helping your competitor to understand when he is about to apply an improper action (such as in a drop or re-drop situation).

- Pay attention and try to at least inform the player of the proper options and procedures.

Next month our Tournament is an Individual Low Net. We are having some great weather and the course is greening up and looking good. This should make for a super large field so sign up early and as always put your request to play early, late, mid time or whatever and I will do my best to honor them.

Warning: In Tournament events, all competitors need to sign their scorecard and ensure the marker has signed as well. If you are in a team event, both competitors should sign the attest line. In the future audits when I find this has not been done I am going to initial the blank line with my Initials.....DQ

*Editor's note - Some players worry about being penalized for giving advice when they are trying to be a good sport and help a competitor. To avoid this situation, open the conversation by asking a question instead of giving advice. For example, if a player is about to make a mistake, you can ask “Do you understand your options in this situation?” or “What is your intention here?” You can discuss the options available, as long as you don't tell the player which one you think is better – let the player decide based on the information available.*

- Our Pro Shop professionals are also welcome.

## Prize Money

Other than rooms and golf, the major expense is the awards ceremony/ buffet—please check “no” on the entry form if you do not plan to attend because I have to pay in advance based on the number of people that sign up to attend. No cost for significant other for Awards Ceremony but \$30 for each additional guest. There is a built-in discount for those who stay at the Aquarius to encourage socializing and fun. After room, golf, and awards ceremony costs, the remainder of the entry fee goes into prize money and allows for substantial payoffs in each flight and very sizeable skins pots. For the Thursday informal skins game, \$54 goes to green fees and \$10.50 into gross and \$10.50 into net skins pot.

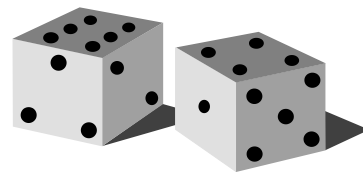
