DESCRIPTION: The BP H-70 is fairly RARE, as it was made only one year (1969). In 1970 the design was tweaked a little and a few higher-end features dropped, and it was rebranded as the Predator. This is a high quality all-purpose recurve with a few flaws. The good: Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Double-sided overlay tips. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in good condition. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. The bad: a few filled drill holes and some stain issues in the sight window (see pics). A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in fair condition. Except for the filled holes, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
