- 1. FIND A LOCATION WITH SUITABLE SUN EXPOSURE FOR PLANT.
- 1. DIG YOUR HOLE AN INCH OR TWO SHALLOWER AND AT LEAST TWICE AS WIDE AS ROOTBALL.
- 1. IF THERE ARE LOTS OF ROOTS ON THE OUTSIDE EDGE, GENTLY BREAK UP ROOTS WITH YOUR HAND.
- 1. WHEN PLANTED IN THE HOLE, MAKE SURE THE TOP OF THE ROOTBALL IS JUST ABOVE SOIL LEVEL.
- 1. PREPARE A MIX OF 75% NATIVE SOIL AND 25% SOIL AMENDMENT.
- 1. FILL THE HOLE TO EXISTING SOIL LEVEL WITH PREPARED MIX AND TAMP DOWN. DO NOT COVER TOP OF ROOTBALL WITH SOIL. WATER IN THOROUGHLY.
- 1. COVER WITH 2 INCHES OF MULCH. KEEP MULCH OFF OF PLANT STEM.
- 1. HIGH PHOSPHORUS FERTILIZERS ARE GREAT TO INCORPORATE INTO THE SOIL MIX WHEN YOU PLANT.
