### AGREEMENT TO ATTEND/PARTICIPATE

Note that while the majority of the sessions are conducted during school hours, each student is also equally committed and required to attend all other activities which include:

- Orientation Meeting on Thursday, September 6, 2018 from 6:00-9:00 pm (Student and at least one parent);
- MANDATORY Retreat on Sunday, September 9, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., in its entirety, which includes travel time to and from the retreat (No make-ups allowed for this session);
- Friday evening TLC holiday party (usually Friday of first weekend in December);
- Lighted Parade and Tree Lighting with the TLC group in December, unless required to participate in the parade as a member of another school group, (band, cheerleaders, Lariettes, etc.) (usually first Saturday in December);
- Weekend and evening planning sessions required for the community service project;
- Work on the actual community service project.

Attendance at all program sessions, along with the above-mentioned events are required to graduate from this program. Any absences, other than a school-related activity, such as State UIL competition; school athletic game/match, etc., must be made up, as determined by the facilitators (the make-up time to exceed time missed). Note that only in extenuating circumstances will make-ups be allowed.

Unexcused absences or failure to make up other absences, as determined by the facilitators, will result in not being able to graduate from this program. All communications regarding missed sessions should be made between the student and the designated communications facilitator.
