Gospel Matthew 23:25-28, 37-39 25 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you cleanse the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of extortion and self-indulgence. 26 Blind Pharisee, first cleanse the inside of the cup and dish, that the outside of them may be clean also.27 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed

tombs which indeed appear beautiful outwardly, but inside are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness. <u>28</u> Even so you also outwardly appear righteous to men, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness. <u>37</u> "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing! <u>38</u> See! Your house is left to you desolate <u>39</u> for I say to you, you shall see Me no more till you say, 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!' "




