# Jay Wilson from Fair Maps Arizona (FMA) will be joining us to discuss redistricting.

Every 10 years, Arizona redraws the political boundaries of political districts like LD23. Arizona is one of only a few states that uses an Independent Redistricting Commission (IRC) to draw its congressional and legislative district maps. Each time the maps are redrawn, the IRC's actions have been the subject of extensive litigation that has had to be resolved by either the Arizona Supreme Court or the United States Supreme Court. Further, last time the maps were redrawn, there were concerns that the IRC drew maps that did not follow the Arizona constitution, and purposefully advantaged a specific group (DEMOCRATS!). Jay will talk about the process and ask for your help to make the maps fair as the IRC makes the rounds in Arizona redrawing the map. Be ready to listen, learn, and volunteer/contribute to help.

# Dan Farley, LD23 PC and Conservative Activist will discuss activist tools and processes.

Dan will provide examples on how he has helped recruit patriots into the Party and his view on organizing, plugging in, and even recruiting conservative candidates for running for offices around Arizona. Wear your thinking cap; and then plan to attend LD23 PC training to supercharge your activism.
