

**DE TOUR VILLAGE COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
OCTOBER 5, 2015**

The regular meeting of the De Tour Village Council was held on Monday, October 5, 2015 at 7:00pm at the De Tour Village Memorial Hall. **Economic Development:** Rob Bloch informed Council property for Farmers' Market closed with sellers on October 1, 2015. Looking into cost for LED signage to replace former Schopp's Used Car sign on farmers' market property. The sign would be programmed remotely from clerk's office and promote the Village/Township events. Mr. Bloch asked Council if he should further his research. Council agreed to go for it! Cloverland emailed Clerk with cost for the winter lights and a solution to estimate a monthly cost versus running power lines to meter each decorative light. Discussion of a stanchion near the Water Plant for added power during festivals, Bob Trudo suggested that an electrical panel be placed at Water Plant, as plant has plenty of capability to add more amperage. Council and Rob Bloch agreed with Bob Trudo's suggestion.

A motion made by Fred Payment and supported by Jason Fountain to complete work for an electrical panel on the outside of the Water Plant Building spring 2016.
