This fall, the Missions' Team would like to introduce a new ministry endeavor.

A new diaper initiative will allow us as a non-profit organization to purchase diapers of all sizes at very low prices. We would like to raise some money through some \$5 offerings over the next few months to begin a ministry which will benefit families with newborn children and families struggling to pay for diapers.

Additionally, we pray that families within our congregation would help support this ministry through other financial gifts.

As this ministry begins, our goal is to be able to deliver packs of new diapers to families with newborn children in our community and our nearby communities as we find out about families who are bringing new babies into the world.

We would then drop off a pack of diapers, along with a prayer note from our congregation to that family, and then later follow up with another package of diapers as that child grows.

Reports:

Recording Secretary: Meeting minutes from the last council meeting on 3/14/2016 were read prior to the meeting. Motion to accept the minutes for the past meeting was made by Ed Gahler, 2nd by Steve Turnow. MC.

- Pastor Kyle had a stain glass window company come and look at the church windows. He is currently waiting on the estimate to be received. Further discussion will be held at the next council meeting regarding the estimate.

Church & Ministry – Met to give Rhonda her six month follow up for janitorial services; a satisfactory rating was given. The committee discussed her responsibilities and duties of the janitorial job, as well as the timing of when the cleaning occurs.
