 - A. Sports teams volunteers and recreation members for pavilion**

Chairwoman S. Rude stated the Field of Dreams Car Show is coming up on Saturday the 28th, with the rain date as the 29th. It's supposed to be a nice weekend so the rain date will hopefully not be needed. The onsite registration begins at 9:00am and the show starts at 10:00am until 3:00pm. She reminded sports teams they need to contribute their time at the car show in order to fulfill their requirements to receive their annual funding from the township. All the sports teams are signed up to participate at the event already.

2. Trails Committee

Secretary V. Galizia stated that the Open Space Committee is trying to find volunteers to join a Trails Committee. The committee would research areas that connect one municipality to another through trails. It would be through existing easements and the committee will be responsible for maintaining the trails. OPEN DISUSSION

J. Calvani asked if there was an update on the defibrillator certification class. Chairwoman S. Rude stated none of the sports teams contacted her or Secretary V. Galizia to give a day that works best for them. J. Calvani stated he would contact the hospital to set a date up for the class and contact the sports teams with the date. The sports teams agreed they would make it mandatory for all coaches to get certified.

Vice Chairman J. Cutler stated the bocci ball court is completed down at the park. He stated the town approved having a lock case with two sets of bocci balls available to the public to use. If someone would like to use the bocci ball set they would go to the municipal building to get the key to be able to access them. J. Cutler stated Bryce would like to try to have a sign posted on the shed by the bocci ball court stating the rules of the game and how to play.

K. Kandel stated the Recreation Committee could have tournaments on Hampton Day.

The Recreation Committee thanked Bryce Cutler for the work he put into the bocci ball court and asked Secretary V. Galizia to write a formal thank you letter to him.

PUBLIC SESSION

Soccer representative L. Kelly asked if she could bring a new 2013 Chevy Malibu to the car show again this year. She stated they had a sweepstakes to raffle the car off at a different date. Chairwoman S. Rude stated she would check with Township Administrator E. Klose to see if she would need to get a raffle license for that since it's a sweepstakes through Chevy. She asked L. Kelly to check with Chevy to see if they had a license for it.

L. Kelly also stated she had to ask the KRHS team to leave the field that week. They were on the fields past 5:00pm. She said she just walked over and nicely asked them to vacate the fields and they didn't give her any problems. Chairwoman S. Rude stated there is a meeting set up with Chris Carroll to see if they will offer additional maintenance of the fields since they are using them so frequently. K. Kandel stated he will look into their schedule and pass it along to them so they know when they will be on the fields.

Basketball S. Bell asked if after the car show the board in front of the municipal building can be changed to say basketball registrations are open. There will be registrations at McKeown School on October 16th and 17th from 6:00-7:00pm.
