Reports of Subcommittees

Equipment Subcommittee: Gary Christopher discussed the following:

- 1. Gary gave a brief overview of the ordering of the current model of the eco-harvester.
 - a. Current Version #2.5 Eco-harvester is listed at \$84,498
 - b. They previously listed a 15% discount for orders placed by October. Gary will confirm if this is still available.
 - c. Gary stated they make 29 units a year and will likely increase production as the machine is gaining in popularity in all areas.
- 2. Operation of the unit will require only one operator with support staff on shore to transport weeds. The disposal of weeds after harvesting will be going to one of several places nearby. The town will take all weeds at the transfer station at no cost and the farm will also take as many weeds as we can deliver.
- 3. A question from the audience asking if a priority list of property owners who pay a fee would be a consideration. Tim responded that currently we plan on doing weed removal at no cost to property owners. Starting with shorelines and moving toward the middle. The exact starting point has not been determined but it makes sense to start at the upper reservoir and progress downstream.

Fundraising Subcommittee: Dave Shelberg discussed the following:
