We will keep a moderate pace along varying terrain (hills, roots, rocks, mud etc.). Dress for the weather, and we suggest bug spray, sun block, water and a light snack. Once we arrive at the northern portion of the park, on Morse Loop, we will take a little 10 minute break to take in the view before we continue back to the visitor center. Rain will cancel.
