AHEC Student Housing Contract



- 1. No smoking of any kind (including marijuana), recreational drugs (including edibles), or alcohol allowed in the house.
- 2. No visitors or overnight guests permitted.
- 3. No pets of any kind permitted.

- 4. No weapons of any kind including firearms, knives, explosives (fireworks, ammunition, etc), bow and arrows, paint or BB guns, or any item that is a reasonable facsimile are permitted.
- 5. You may use the kitchen facilities. Bring your own small set of pots and pans to use. It is expected that you leave the area clean after use.
- 6. Bed linens may or may not be furnished, please check with your Host. Your Host will inform you of expectations for changing the bed linens. Please bring your own bath towels and toiletries.
- 7. You are expected to use your own cell phone for communication. <u>Under no circumstances would you be allowed to charge phone calls to your Host's telephone.</u>
- 8. Arrangements for the use of the laundry facilities are made with the Host. Students are expected to access laundry facilities in the community.
- 9. The volume of any electronic device must be such that it does not disturb others.
- 10. You must always keep your living area clean by cleaning up after yourself throughout your stay and by cleaning your bedroom and bathroom before leaving. All housing may undergo cleaning and inspection before and after each rotation. Any damages or untidiness will result in damage or cleaning fees assessed directly to the student.
- 11. You may be in the same house as another student of the opposite gender. If this is a problem, please contact the Regional AHEC Office immediately!
- 12. Ask the Host if there are additional house rules that you need to adhere to that may not be listed here. <u>Disrespect of the Host and the house rules will result in termination of your use of that home and will prevent you from using AHEC for future housing needs.</u>
- 13. Upon your arrival, the Host will provide you with a house key or key entrance code. Please inquire about expectations to maintain the safety and security of the house (locking doors etc.) while you are living there.
- 14. Students who wish to arrive early or stay beyond the dates of their rotation (excluding the night before or after) do so at the discretion of the Host, are at the Student's own expense, and must be arranged through the Regional Housing Coordinator.
- 15. You are expected to provide your own transportation throughout your rotation and to discuss parking restrictions with your Host. Any costs associated with mileage or parking or being towed for parking in a restricted area is the responsibility of the student and will not be reimbursed by AHEC.
