
DAY 2 Thursday, June 13

Today we wander through the **Badlands National Park** and the **Ben Reifel Visitor Center**. The Badlands, is unique terrain created from years of erosion and weathering. The park's 244,000 acres protect an expanse of mixed-grass prairie where bison, bighorn sheep, prairie dogs, and black-footed ferrets live today. Stops along the way will allow for some great pictures and viewing. Then we will go to the amazing **Wall Drug Store**, where you may have lunch on your own or just try the ice cream. We then head to Rapid City, where we will make stops at the **Black Hills Visitors Center** and **Journey Museum**— which brings together the history of both the Western Great Plains as well as Native Americans—before heading to our **Hilton Garden Inn**, our home for the next two nights. DAY 3 Friday, June 14

This morning we will visit **Mount Rushmore** and view the majestic figures of George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln, surrounded by the beauty of the Black Hills of South

Dakota. Later we travel to Hill City where we board the 1880 Train for a trip back in time. The old steam engine will take us through the beautiful Black Hills to Keystone. Then we are off to **Bear Country** USA, where we will drive in our motor coach and view grizzlies, moose, wolves, mountain lions, sheep and more in their natural habitat. Our final stop today will be at the Fort Hays Chuck wagon Supper and Music Variety Show. You will enjoy a good old Chuck wagon dinner and great entertainment. (B, D)



DAY 4 Saturday, June 15

After packing up, we travel to **Custer State Park** where we will enjoy a **jeep ride** through the park, you will want to keep your eyes open for deer, buffalo and wild burros. We will have a included buffet lunch at the **State Game Lodge**.
