Workshop Description

This workshop will explore the types of searches that have been seen at elite trials around the country. Topics will include competition strategies for different types of searches as well as pre-trial training to prepare for the unique challenges of the elite level. Working teams will have a chance to participate in a variety of elite-type searches, with at least 6 different types of searches being included over the two days. Each team's needs will be assessed to help create individualized training plans and trialing strategies.

Those with their NW3-elite title and registering for both days will have first priority for working spaces. If working spaces remain after December 20th then teams that have earned at least one NW3 title will be considered for working spaces. Handlers of all levels are welcome to audit.

Registration is limited to 10 working spaces and 20 auditors each day.

Spaces will be reserved in the order that qualified registrations/payments are received.

Instructor Bio

Laurel Scarioni has been working as a professional dog trainer since 2003 and has been a Certified Nose Work Instructor since 2010. Laurel is an NACSW™ Certifying Official and has been the CO for multiple Elite trials around the country. In addition, she competes at the elite level and has competed at two National Invitationals with Myrtle Mae, ELT2, so is very familiar with the mental challenges of competing at this level. Laurel has been a full-time instructor at the K9 Nose Work® camps in Colorado and Pennsylvania and has taught workshops around the country on various nose work topics.
