

2 spots still available


Supplies Cherry Pickin' Class April (7, 202)

To make table runner 42 5x5 squares
1 yard white
½ yard binding
1½ yard backing

OR to make one "plate"
18 5x5 squares
White background at least 15 x 15"

Usually sewing supplies - iron, cutter, mat, machine, thread and
DOUBLE WIDE 4 PATCH DRESDEN TEMPLATE available at quilts and lace or online.
