Objective:

- To understand the rural life of Arunachal Pradesh
- To understand the work nature of ArSRLM as an organization.
- To be well informed about the nature of work one would be engaged as the team member of the ArSRLM.

Assignment for RAT

1. Post: CC

- Study the history of the village, settlement pattern, demographic details, resources available, major traditions and festivals, livelihoods pattern, seasonality calendar, existing institutions, interdependence and gender relations.
- Identify 3 families—one very poor, poor and well off
 - Analyze their annual income and expenditure pattern.
 - Map vulnerabilities, shocks and distress and the various mechanisms of coping with them.
- Study the processes and norms followed in SHG formation, meeting and savings, credit activities and other activities involved in it.
 - What all are the training that SHG members are given.
- Identify the families who are not part of any SHG and understand why they are left out.
 - Map out how many women members of the village are not included in the SHG folds.
 - Map out how do existing SHG members think of including the left out women into SHG folds.
