It was a wild and unpredictable September but now our attention turns towards October. What did we learn in this first month? As far as which schools stepped up and which schools stubbed their toe? Alabama, Ohio State, Michigan, Louisville and Texas A&M are the 5 schools that have looked the most dominant on a consistent basis thus far this season but Clemson, Wisconsin, Houston, Tennessee, Nebraska, Baylor, Washington and Stanford have also proven that they are capable of great things. Schools like Florida State, Ole Miss and Michigan State have also shown moments of brilliance but losses are a part of their resumé and they'll have to overcome those losses as the season continues. Possibly the team that has the most difficult road ahead as far as trying to get in position to be considered as an option for the College Football Playoff Selection Committee is Ole Miss. The Rebels have looked very good in every game at one point in those contests, but second half collapses vs Florida State and Alabama might be too much to overcome. We still believe that most of those schools will end up with successful seasons, it's just that they know their fates as far as winning a title earlier than most. # GAME-OF-THE-WEEK



## LOUISVILLE AT CLEMSON



The high scoring Louisville Cardinals travel to Clemson to face the defending ACC Champion Tigers in a nationally televised primetime game on ABC at 8:00 PM EDT.

Through the first month of the season, no player has been hotter than Louisville QB, Lamar Jackson. He has been spectacular through the first 4 games of the 2016 season. He is playing about as good as Deshaun Watson did for Clemson last year when the Tigers played for the national championship. Can he and his Louisville teammates keep it up? As good as they looked against Florida State, it's hard to imagine that they would play that good of a game against this Clemson defense, especially at Memorial Stadium. Bobby Petrino has done another great job rebuilding the Louisville program in his second stint as the Cardinals head coach. His goal to get the Louisville program to compete year-in and year-out for the ACC title just like Dabo Swinney has done at Clemson. It's certain that Petrino will be pursued by other schools at the end of this season and it will be interesting to see how that unfolds and if Louisville can retain him.

Clemson and Louisville have only played twice. In 2014 Clemson won 23-17 and last year the Tigers won 20-17. This looks like a classic game just waiting to happen. Do we go with the team with the most overall talent, which is Clemson or do we go with teem with the hottest player at the most important position, which is Louisville? After looking at it, we're going with the home team. We're going with Clemson 35-31.

## FOOTBALL TIDBITS

Houston wide receiver D'Eriq King had a passing touchdown, a receiving touchdown and a kickoff return for a touchdown in Saturday's win over Texas State. The last FBS player to do that in one game was Toledo's Eric Page in 2010 against Central Michigan.

Lamar Jackson is the only FBS player to have multiple seven-touchdown games in one season in the last 10 seasons. Lamar Jackson has 10 passing touchdowns this season. His 10th last season came in his 11th game. He had 12 all of last season.

Stanford now has nine straight wins over UCLA. That is the Bruins' longest losing streak vs any opponent since they joined what is now the Pac-12 back in 1928.

Notre Dame and USC both have three losses before playing a game in the month of October. This is the second time in the last 50 years both have had three losses before October (They both also has 3 in 2001).

Wisconsin's two wins against AP top-10 opponents this season lead the FBS and are as many as the Badgers had in the previous 10 seasons combined.

Alabama recorded their 18th shutout under Nick Saban, the most in the FBS during that span. Ohio State is 2nd with 11 during that span.

There have been eight pass receptions of 90-plus yards in Texas A&M history. Josh Reynolds is the only player to catch more than one. He had the 92-yarder vs Arkansas this past Saturday and a 95-yard catch against Vanderbilt last season. Kevin Sumlin has 11 wins vs AP-ranked opponents which is second in Texas A&M history to R.C. Slocum who has 17. Slocum's win percentage in such games: .395. Sumlin: .500.

Cal has played 6 straight games in which both teams have scored 30+ points, which is the longest streak since at least 1937.

One of the best traditions in college football is the rolling of the Toomer's Corner oak trees following big wins at Auburn. Unfortunately, someone thought it would be a good idea to light the toilet paper on fire after Auburn's win over LSU. The local fire department was able to put the blaze out but unfortunately there was some damage to that tree and we'll have to see what the prognosis for that tree will be later on.

## STADIUMS OF THE PAST SERIES: STOLL FIELD / McLEAN STADIUM



The former home of Kentucky from 1916-1972, Stoll Field/McLean Stadium boasts that it is the location where the first college football game ever played in the south was played back in 1880 between Transylvania University and Centre College. (Transylvania won 13¾ - 0). Stoll Field was eventually built on that plot of land.

The field was named for alum, Judge Richard C Stoll. The actual concrete structure was dedicated as McLean Stadium in 1924 in honor of Price McLean, a player for Kentucky who was fatally injured in a game vs the University of Cincinnati in 1923.

The stadium was located right next to the former home of the basketball team (Memorial Coliseum). It was a two-side concrete stadium that had steel bleachers in both endzones. An interesting feature was the fact that when Kentucky installed permanent lights, they were built up to the back of the stands and when they enlarged the stadium, they left the lights where they were, thus they had 6 light standards sticking out of the grandstands (3 on each side) obstructing the views of those who were unlucky enough to have seats behind the support poles.

By the time the late 60's rolled around, it was apparent that the program had out grown this facility which had a capacity of 37,000. There simply was not enough room to expand due to Memorial Coliseum on one side and buildings on the other side so the decision was made to build a new stadium instead. In 1973 Kentucky opened Commonwealth Stadium and the university razed McLean Stadium a few years later. That site was eventually used to construct the Singletary Center for the Arts. Kentucky's all-time wonloss record at Stoll Field/McLean Stadium was 146-99-8 .593.
