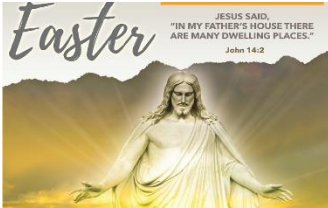

March for Life - 2018 - Bus to Ottawa - THURSDAY, MAY 10TH

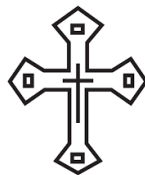
