Winter Driving

When the weather is really threatening, ask yourself, "Do I really need to make this trip?" If you have no choice, then proceed with caution and make sure you have made the necessary preparations. Start with putting an emergency kit in the car and reviewing your winter driving skills.

Here Are Suggestions For What to Pack:

Jumper cables to restart engine Cat litter or sand for tire traction on snow and ice Shovel to scrape snow away from tires Ice scraper to clear windshield Warm clothes - gloves, a hat, sturdy boots, warm jacket and even a change of clothes Blankets to keep warm inside the vehicle Flashlights and extra batteries for increased visibility First aid kit - also pack necessary medications in case you are stuck on the road Food - pack items containing protein such as nuts and energy bars Water - bring enough for each person in your car and any pets

Also Consider

A cell phone with a list of emergency numbers.

Fill your gas tank.

If you find yourself stranded, be safe and stay in your car, put on your flashers, call for help, and wait until it arrives.

Check your Route

If you are traveling out of town, always check your route and the forecast. Make sure that you inform at least two people of your travel plans, route, and anticipated arrival time. Before hitting the road, clear snow and ice off of your vehicle. Many accidents are caused because of poor visibility. Making sure that your vehicle is cleaned off completely will allow a clear line of vision. Don't forget to clean off your headlights, taillights and brake lights. Give yourself some extra time - it is better to leave early and arrive safely. Remember that bridges and overpasses freeze before other road surfaces do so approach them cautiously.


