The Malachi Boys' Home was organized and incorporated by the State of North Carolina as a non-profit organization in 1982. It began as a ministry of Bethel Baptist Missions in South Boston, VA. In 2004, the BBM Board of Directors felt that the work should be placed under local church leadership and Oak Level Baptist Church of Stokesdale, NC assumed the responsibility of this ministry.

Our Purpose
