SB 1383 Waiver Form



California Senate Bill (SB) 1383 is a state law that aims to reduce methane emissions created from landfilled organic materials, such as food scraps, paper towels, and yard debris. The regulations require all residents and commercial entities to subscribe to regular collection of organic materials, otherwise called "green bin service" or "compost service". Some commercial businesses/entities may be eligible for a waiver from organics collection requirements if they can provide evidence to show minimal generation of organics or a physical space constraint. Please note that waivers are only valid for 5 years. An inspection may be necessary to verify qualification for renewal.
