Upload continuing education training certificates onto Certemy (training certificates must be signed by trainer and state the number of CE hours provided for course). NOTE: No more than 50% of CE hours can be from online course. If you are the trainer for a course, you can claim 25% of the approved CEs as your CEUs for renewal.
	You will invite your supervisor through the system. The supervisor will provide and upload a letter of endorsement for your renewal. Upload your current certificate into the system as proof of you credential. A digital copy of your
	certificate will be available on the system when your renewal application is approved The late fee will be required when the CPSW certificate is expired and must be paid to the board at www.nmcbbhp.org on the Fees page. You must email the board for request assist in how to submit application and all required documents and the original certificate. EXPIRED CREDENTIAL: When your certificate is expired, you are considered non-certified and your credential will be placed on inactive status. This board must receive a completed application with required documentation and be
	approved within 90 days of certificate expiration date. A late fee must be included with the application certification. (Inactive status means that your credential is no longer valid until it is reinstated)
