**Applications Update.**

The Chairman had received an email from PM suggesting that the Gladman application had been turned down under the Planning Committee's delegated powers. No update as yet on the application for the 32 houses on Walcot Lane.

**Richard Eccles** application for four bungalows has been refused and he has appealed.

**Crown Developments** application appeal for three houses on Brickyard Lane has been upheld.

**North Oak:** Wychavon is still pursuing the Judicial Review .

**The Bovis application** meeting is on 5th February. KS and SW to speak. KS said that the PC is reluctantly backing approval for 90 homes to be built as this number will justify a road crossing with lights.

SS noted an application online from **Richborough Estates** for houses on Stonebow Road. KS said that PM says we MUST resubmit all our objections as they are not carried over.
