## Preschool Children Benefit from Outdoor Play in Many Ways!

The beautiful spring weather is finally here. It is the perfect time to experience the great outdoors with your child. Outdoor play in all weather helps children grow up to be more resilient. Children who are allowed to play outside in the rain, sun, heat or cold develop different skills than children who are taught to come inside whenever the weather is not perfect. Before television and computers, it used to be normal for kids to spend much more time outside. Now, many children feel less comfortable outside than inside simply because they are not used to it. Family, teachers and mentors should encourage children with smiles to experience the outdoors in all weather. In Reggio Emilia the concept of the "environment as the third teacher" is very important. Children learn more from experiencing the outdoors.

Things to do outside include: Playing games, watching birds and bugs at work, helping start a flower or vegetable garden, digging, flying a kite, riding a bike or going for a hike at a park, or just relaxing.

Being outdoors encourages children to be curious about the world and ask questions. Don't let fears of too much sun, bugs or allergies get in the way.
