The Colorado Department of Agriculture & the State Veterinarians office has recommended the cancelling of all rabbit shows and activities. The ARBA has asked all breeders in Arizona, New Mexico, Colorado, Utah and Western Texas to voluntarily recognize a rabbit herd quarantine until the RHDV2 infections can be effectively managed. They also strongly suggest that all breeders, at a minimum, enact a bio-security protocol to help protect your rabbits. I would encourage all of you to learn as much as you can about the RHD virus and follow the recommendations of the Agriculture Department & the ARBA.

I encourage all of you to contact any Board member with your ideas on how to make RMHS a stronger club. The new Board is discussing Convention alternatives, virtual rabbit shows, and other activities. PLEASE SHARE YOUR IDEAS.

Seeing as this is my first newsletter- allow me to introduce myself. My name is Graham Thomas, and I am a recent "rejoin" to the rabbit world. My family grew up showing rabbits for many years, and I got out of it when I went to school and about 2 years ago returned to the hobby. I have been enjoying working at shows again, so decided to run for the RMHS board. I hope to be of assistance to you, the membership!

As we all know, we do not have many, if any, shows on the horizon for us this year. It's time to really focus on your herd, and on your bio security. Here is what I'm working on in regards to this:

- 1. The old adage "Show the best, eat the rest" is more prevalent than ever now. Use the most critical eye for your herd. No reason to keep an above average rabbit just for the tables.
- 2. Nothing out or in. Use the quality pieces I have to progress. With transport being completely inadvisable at this time, there is no reason to get distracted with that hot shot rabbit you wanted at convention. And please, stop transporting! Let's help slow down RHDV2
- 3. I have added a sanitizer mat that I can use with vikron-S to my barn, and only wear specific shoes into it
- 4. Increased fly control- spraying pans, cleaning more often, and added mesh coverings to doors to allow for increased airflow but not increased insects
- 5. And to just repeat #2- nothing out or in! No sale is worth moving this virus around. With all going on, the best route is to use this time to get a good outlet for your culls, and cull hard. Let's all use this time to get our herds ready for the tables when they pick back up! I am excited to see the progress everyone is able to make at this time

I hope you are all keeping cool and helping your rabbits to do the same. It has already started out to be a hot one!

As we navigate the current RHDV2 circumstance, I would like to take a moment and discuss some ways to help protect your herd. Keeping your rabbits safe can be a pretty overwhelming feat, especially if your barn is not completely enclosed. If your barn can be exposed to wild rabbits, consider installing some type of perimeter fence the wild rabbits cannot get through. Additionally, performing a deep cleaning in you barn with a strong bleach mixture can help kill diseases. When bringing anything into your barn, consider sanitizing it. Something as simple as buying a bag of feed and carrying it into the barn could bring the virus into your barn.

Keeping positive in these times is very important. Soon we will all be able to gather (hopefully not six feet apart) and share the camaraderie of shows. Continue breeding, continue improving your herd, and continue practicing biosecurity measures.



Colorado's Virtual Visual Rabbit Show Rules:

There will be a \$25.00 BIS award and a \$15.00 RIS award. For every entry paid .25 cents will be donated to the RMHS youth Scholarship fund. Once awards and expenses and youth donation have been covered any remaining Funds will be distributed equally to our judges for that show.

The winner will be judged by selected ARBA judges and then the breed winners will compete for Best In Show. We realize that not all measurements of the ARBA standard of perfection can be met with the virtual show, the judges will use their utmost integrity and fairness to pick the animal that they feel Based on the Photo that best represents the closest to the standard of perfection.

We know not all things are even- fur, density, texture and finish cannot be observed, Body firmness etc cannot be felt. And yes this may be a show of the best Photographer however we are showing what we can.

The first show will be from June 14-20th. All entries must be entered by midnight June 12th.

There is a \$1.00 entry fee to cover the cost of the BIS and RIS award and anything left over to be distributed to our judges.

All entries MUST be ARBA recognized breeds and currently able to show on the show table at an ARBA show.

We know this first attempt will not be perfect however we are making an attempt to let you once again enjoy your hobby and not just feeding those hungry mouths.

RMHS Youth 2020 Graduating Senior SANDIS WALTER



MESSAGE FROM MARCS CONVENTIONS

FOR THE PAST FIVE YEARS THE MARCS CONVENTION COMMITTEE HAS BEEN WORKING TIRELESSLY TO BRING THE ARBA MEMBERSHIP AN AMAZING CONVENTION IN HARRISBURG, PA. WE WANTED HISTORY TO BE SWEET AS IT REPEATS.

HOWEVER OVER THE PAST FEW MONTHS WE HAVE BEEN FOLLOWING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND THE OUTBREAK OF RHDV2 IN THE SOUTH-WEST. BOTH OF THESE THREATEN THE HEALTH OF OUR EXHIBITORS AND THEIR ANIMALS. BASED ON GUIDANCE WE HAVE RECEIVED REGARD-ING COVID-19, IT HAS ONLY BECOME CLEARER THAT LARGE EVENTS WILL BE DIFFICULT IF NOT IMPOSSIBLE TO HAPPEN FOR THE FORESEEA-BLE FUTURE WITHOUT DISREGARDING THE GUIDANCE WE HAVE BEEN RECEIVING AND THE POLICIES OF OUR LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL OFFICIALS. THE OUTLOOK REGARDING RHDV2 ALSO DOES NOT LOOK SO GOOD BUT TIME WILL TELL HOW THAT VIRUS SPREADS AND POTENTIALLY HOW IT IMPACTS THE WAY WE SHOW RABBITS IN THE FUTURE

AS A RESULT, WE HAVE BEEN FORCED TO MAKE THE HEARTBREAKING DECISION TO CANCEL THE IN PERSON 2020 ARBA CONVENTION & SHOW IN HARRISBURG. THIS DECISION WAS NOT MADE LIGHTLY AND DONE AFTER CONSULTING OUR CONVENTION VETERINARIAN, CONVENTION EPIDEMIOLOGIST, KEY MEMBERS OF THE ARBA BOARD, THE PENNSYLVANIA FARM SHOW COMPLEX, THE HERSHEY/HARRISBURG VISITORS BUREAU, AND OTHERS. WE ALL AGREED THAT IT WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE TO PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING AT THIS EVENT AND ABIDE BY LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL GUIDANCE. ALSO CURRENT ARBA RHDV2 RESTRICTIONS WOULD ELIMINATE A GROWING PORTION OF OUR MEMBERSHIP FROM SHOWING AT OUR EVENT IF THAT CONTINUES OVER THE NEXT MONTHS AND IF THE VIRUS SPREADS FURTHER.

OUR TEAM IS MOURNING THIS UNFORTUNATE ANNOUNCEMENT WITH YOU, HOWEVER THERE IS A SILVER LINING TO THIS DARK CLOUD. THE MARCS CONVENTION COMMITTEE HAS SWITCHED GEARS AND WILL BE HOLDING A VIRTUAL RABBIT & CAVY CONVENTION THAT OFFERS A LOT OF THE SAME ACTIVITIES AS A CONVENTION JUST VIRTUALLY. THIS WILL INCLUDE JUDGING USING AN ENTRY SYSTEM THAT WILL HIDE THE IDENTITY OF THE EXHIBITOR AND MUCH MORE. THIS EVENT WILL ALSO BE ABOUT GIVING BACK TO ARBA RABBIT COMMUNITY. SOON THE MARCS BOARD WILL ANNOUNCE BENEFACTORS THAT WILL RECEIVE THE MAJORITY OF THE PROCEEDS FROM THIS HISTORIC EVENT.

IN THE COMING DAYS AND WEEKS, WE WILL BE RELEASING MORE INFORMATION AND ENCOURAGE PEOPLE TO CHECK OUT OUR FAQS AT https://www.marcsconventions.com/faq.

PLEASE KNOW THAT OUR ENTIRE TEAM HAS GRAPPLED WITH THIS VERY DIFFICULT DECISION AND WE WERE HOLDING OUT HOPE THAT WE COULD STILL HAVE OUR EVENT AND SHARE WITH EVERYONE THE PLANS WE HAVE BEEN WORKING ON. THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF OUR EXHIBITORS AND THEIR ANIMALS IS OUR NUMBER 1 CONCERN AND BASED ON THE GUIDANCE WE HAVE RECEIVED, WE COULD NOT PROCEED KNOWING THAT WE COULD PUT THAT IN JEOPARDY FOR OUR ATTENDEES AND THEIR ANIMALS.

Please make sure to read and understand the new sweepstakes guidelines. This started January 1st, 2020. There are major changes and everyone needs to be aware. Members will be required to show in a certain amount of shows to qualify for year end awards.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH SHOWS, INC. SWEEPSTAKES RULES

(Revised May 25, 1985)(retroactive to Jan. 1985)(amended May 24, 1986)(amended June 3, 1990)
(amended February 17, 2007)(amended October 12, 1996)amended December 2, 2000)(revised February 22, 2003)(revised January, 2009)
(Complete revision September 2018)

- 1. The RMHS President will appoint the Sweepstakes Chairperson.
- Points will be accumulated on Rocky Mountain High Shows, Inc. sanctioned shows only.
- 3. Points will be accumulated only by members in good standing ** of Rocky Mountain High shows, Inc.
- 4. Sweepstakes year begins on January 1 of each year and will end on December 31 of that year.
- The Sweepstakes Chairperson and Committee members at the end of each year will determine awards to be given at the RMHS annual meeting during RMHS State Convention. The RMHS President is an ex-officio member of this Committee.
- 6. This Award Committee shall have an annual budget not to exceed \$1250 for Open Awards and \$1250 for Youth Awards.
- 7. Awards will be given at the annual meeting/RMHS State Convention.
- Points are to be tabulated regularly and the list of top five exhibitors in each breed shall be published on the RMHS website and in the RMHS
 Newsletter.
- 9. Points will be figured on the basis of show secretary record as submitted to RMHS Sweepstakes keeper.
- 10. Points will be tabulated as follows:
 - a. 1st place 6 times number in class.
 - b. 2nd place 4 times number in class.
 - 3rd place 3 times number in class.
 - d. 4th place 2 times number in class.
 - e. 5th place 1 times number in class.
- In order to qualify for the points as listed, you must have exhibited in the required number of shows. An Open (Adult) breeder would need to have shown in a minimum of 6 (six) RMHS Sanctioned shows for the Sweepstakes Year.
 - a. 25 199 shown in the Breed, FIRST PLACE AWARD ONLY
 - 200 399 shown in the Breed, FIRST PLACE AND SECOND PLACE AWARD.
 - c. 400 and over shown in the Breed, FIRST PLACE, SECOND PLACE, AND THIRD PLACE AWARD.

A Youth Breeder must have exhibited in a minimum of 4 (four) RMHS Sanctioned shows for the Sweepstakes year in order to qualify for the points as listed above.

- a. 10 99 shown in the Breed, FIRST PLACE AWARD ONLY
- b. 100 299 shown in the Breed, FIRST AND SECOND PLACE AWARD.
- c. 300 and over shown in the Breed, FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD PLACE AWARD.
- 12. Quality Points Awards will be calculated as follows:
 - a. Best in Show 100 points, provided 5 rabbits are shown by 3 breeders.
 - b. Reserve in Show 75 points, provided 5 rabbits are shown by 3 breeders
 - Best of Breed 50 points, provided 5 rabbits are shown by 3 breeders
 - d. Best Opposite of Breed 25 points, provided 5 rabbits are shown by 3 breeders.
 - For RMHS sanctioned Specialty shows, only Best of Breed and Best Opposite of Breed points will be given, with the exception of the
 following Specialty shows: French/English Lop, Satin/Mini Satin, Angora. Those will be considered Best in Show and Reserve in
 Show.
- A separate Quality Point Award will be given to the Top three overall breed exhibitors FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD PLACES in both Open and Youth Sweepstakes.
- NOTE: The Sweepstakes/Awards Committee shall have the right to create a "sliding scale" in any year in order to stay within the current approved budget.
- DOUBLE Sweepstakes points will be given for the Annual State Convention show. Quality Points will be excluded from Double points at this show. Any Specialty Club shows taking place at State Convention will also be excluded from DOUBLE points.
- For Meat Pens, there will be a Sweepstakes which will be based as if it were a Breed and points calculated as such.

^{**} Definition of In Good Standing – Current membership paid through the complete Sweepstakes Year of which points are given. A 60 day grace period will be given provided the membership is paid prior to the expiration of the grace period.
