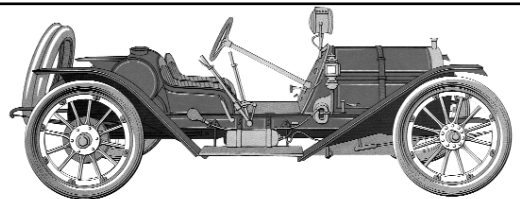
The Club Library

To Sue Albanesius for the delicious desserts at our October General Meeting. Cindy Press has volunteered to bring the cookies for our November meeting.

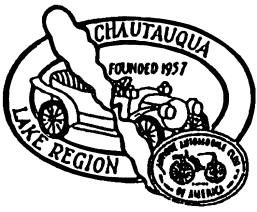
