To check your students' results and to see if your students are eligible for Branch Honors, please go to your teacher home page on www.mtac.org, student list, and student evaluation results.

The deadline to register for the State Convention is **April 15th**. If your students were selected to proceed to convention and they would like to go, you will need to pay the convention fee (\$25 per student) online to secure their spot. This is a non-refundable fee, so make sure your students are committing to convention before registering them. All of this registration is done through your teacher home page on www.mtac.org, student list, and Final Convention App.

*Two letters of recommendation from persons other than the student's current MTAC teacher or family member.

*Proof of community service and other volunteer activities.
