

2025 Ashton Woods Pool Rules and Information

All members are responsible for knowing these rules and discussing them with their household, children and guests. These rules are designed for the safety of all members and the protection of your privileges. Please remember that the rights, privileges and safety of all members, board members and lifeguards should be respected at ALL TIMES.

Failure to follow these rules will be grounds for revocation of pool passes

<u>Ashton Woods Board Members and Lifeguards have the authority to enforce all</u> rules and regulations including:

- Suspending member privileges for any violation of these rules.
- Restricting the use of any audio devices if the volume is too loud.
- Closing the facility for safety, sanitation or weather related issues.
 - Dispose of any articles left at the facility
 - Notify law enforcement if necessary.

<u>Children under the age of 15 years old must be under the direct supervision</u> of an ADULT member at all times

Children are NOT allowed to bring in guests on their own.

All members and guests MUST sign in at the lifeguard desk upon entry

It is NOT the responsibility of lifeguards to remember whether members have previously entered in the past. Verification checks may be done periodically throughout the day by lifeguards and Board Members.

Guest Passes are \$5 per day, per guest

A family is allowed up to 5 guests per visit. Please pay with cash upon entering. Your guests MUST REMAIN UNDER MEMBER ADULT SUPERVISION AT ALL TIMES. You are responsible for your guests for the entirety of their visit to our pool.

Outside Members MUST abide by the same pool rules that apply to our residents

Outside Pool membership is not guaranteed and does not renew yearly. Applications must reapply every year they wish to join. The Board of Directors reserve the right to deny and revoke all membership privileges for non-compliance with pool rules.

The Board Members and Lifeguards are in charge

Whatever they say goes Please show them the respect they deserve while keeping you, your family members and guests safe. Disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated and will result in revocation of Pool Passes.

FOR SAFETY REASONS:

A lifeguard must be on duty at all times whenever the pool is occupied.

The pool will be closed on cloudy days when the outside temperature is 69 degrees or below.

Our contracted pool company and Board of Directors reserve the right to close the pool upon inclement weather.

Members will be asked to leave the pool facility when weather requires that the pool be closed either temporarily or for the day.

All hair longer than shoulder length should be secured with a hair tie.

Glass is NOT permitted inside the pool gates, this includes baby bottles.

NO face masks or snorkel type masks allowed. Goggles are permitted.

Bikes, roller skates, roller blades, skateboards or the like are NOT allowed inside the pool gates.

Eyeglasses needed while in the pool should be secured with a strap.

Small children and weaker swimmers are restricted to pool depths not exceeding their shoulder level (determined by a lifeguard)

Running, dunking, pushing, shoulder riding, chicken-fighting or other horse play is NOT permitted.

Only ONE PERSON at a time is permitted on the diving board.

No flotation or safety devices are to be used off diving board. The diving board is for SWIMMERS only. Swimmers must dive or jump straight out from the board. NO jumping or diving towards either side of the pool and no diving or jumping into a guardians arms. Again, the diving board is for those who can safely swim and dive on their own. No exceptions.

Back flips are NOT permitted from the diving board or pool deck at any time.

No hanging from the diving board, lifeguard stands or lap ropes.

Alcohol is not permitted on the property. Our Lifeguards and Board of Directors have the right to turn away any member or guest believed to be intoxicated.

The Kiddie Pool is for children age 5 or under (unless otherwise given special permission) and children MUST BE SUPERVISED BY THEIR ADULT AT ALL TIMES. There is no lifeguard assigned to the kiddie pool area.

Children cannot be left unattended for ANY TIME for ANY REASON.

Chemical Safety Checks will be called at 45 minutes past each hour to allow for safely checking chemical levels. NO EXCEPTIONS. Only adults 18 or older are allowed in the pool during this time. All others must leave the water.

FOR COURTESY REASONS:

The use of profanity and lewd behavior is NOT permitted. This is a family friendly pool and we proudly operate it as such.

Smoking or Vaping inside the pool gates or pool house is NOT permitted. You must smoke at least 20 feet outside the pool gates, no exceptions. If a child is with you, they cannot be left unattended.

When leaving for the day, please throw away all trash and put chair back to their rightful place. Please return all used floats, life preservers and toys to their locations.

Water and squirt guns are NOT PERMITTED. No exceptions.

Throwing balls or frisbees is not permitted inside the pool.

Shoes MUST be worn when entering the Pool House.

Food and drink are not allowed inside the pool or while sitting on the sides of the pool.

Bathing Suits MUST be worn at all times. Cut-offs, jeans, t-shirts, tank tops and undergarments are not permitted.

Gum is NOT allowed inside the pool gates.

Inappropriate behavior by adults and children alike will NOT BE TOLERATED and are grounds for dismissal. Please report any issues you see to the Lifeguards on Duty or Board Members.

Guests are NOT to enter the pool prior to opening time. Our Pool Management Company, Lifeguards and Board Members may enter at any time.

Suspension from the Pool includes the ENTIRE common area, beginning from the main gate to the Pool Area.. Refusal to leave this area may result in criminal charges.
