Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside. He taught in their synagogues, and everyone praised him.

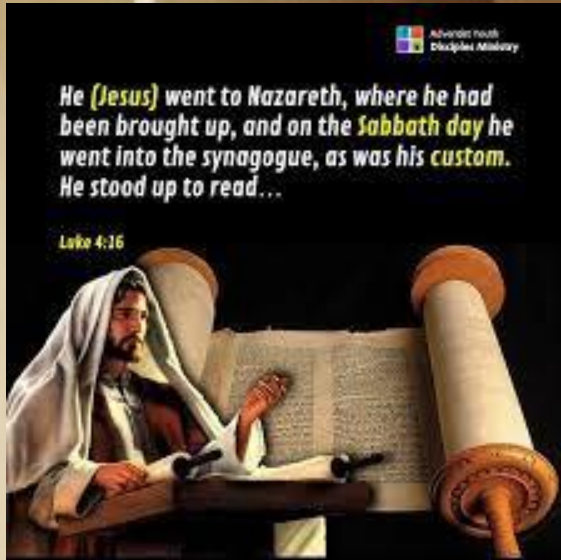

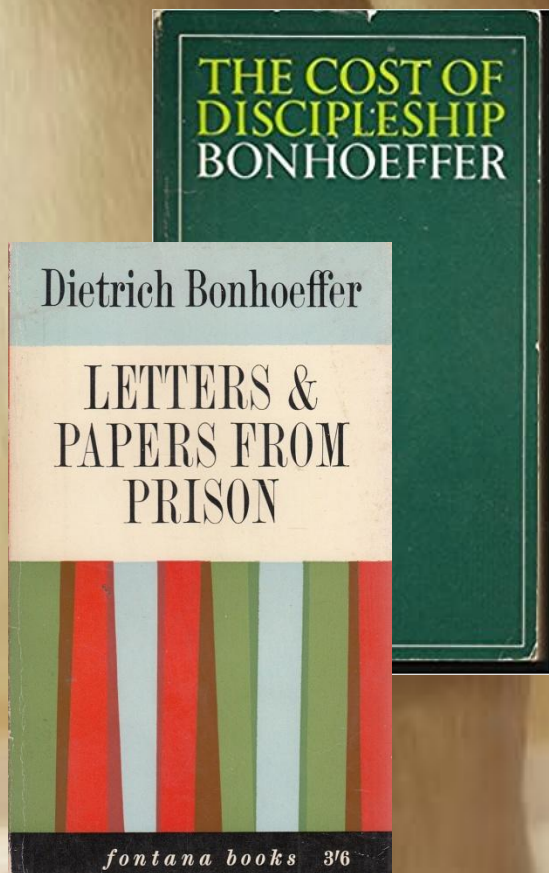
There are churches that reject Jesus.

Cheap grace is grace without discipleship, grace without the cross, grace without Jesus Christ.



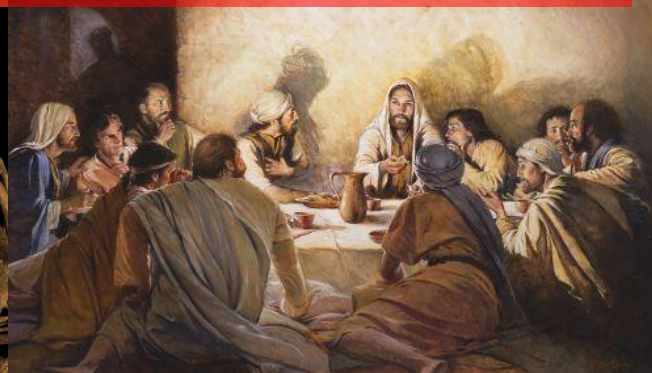
