






DIVIDEND YIELD & RISK METRICS

DIVIDEND METRICS

- GBCD yield of 4.4% is higher than U.S./Int'l equity indexes of 1.4/2.0%
- GBCD yield of 4.4% is higher than the IG Corp Bond index of 3.5%
- Solid dividend yields across all sectors ranging from 2.6% to 9.0%
- Strong dividend income with equity upside and inflation hedge


