NRA Personal Protection In The Home Course

Currently accepted by the State of Michigan as training for those who wish to apply for their Concealed Pistol License (CPL) and far exceeds requirements set forth by the State of Wisconsin.

This class is not designed to teach first-time shooters how to use a handgun. All students must have shooting experience and know how to safely use the handgun they are bringing to class, including the basics of loading, unloading, & shooting; and the gun must function with the ammunition they are using.

Important: The farthest distance we'll be shooting is only 21 feet (7 yards). However, you should be proficient enough with your gun & ammo combination to hit an 8-1/2" x 11" sheet of paper at that distance, even with rapid fire. If you cannot do this, then practice until you can before taking this course.

If desired, I can provide additional training to help you achieve the required proficiency. However, this will need to be prior to taking the CPL course and will have a separate cost structure. Contact me for further details.

Acceptable firearms will be limited to semi-auto pistols and double-action revolvers (w/swing out cylinders). No single action revolvers allowed.

This class teaches the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude essential to the safe and efficient use of a handgun for protection of self and family and to provide information on the law-abiding individual's right to self-defense.

You will need to bring a handgun, 100 rounds of ammo, baseball type cap. Also bring eye & ear protection (if you do not have any, it will be provided at the class), a lunch and real shoes or boots.

We suggest you bring an extra magazine for semi autos or a speed loader for revolvers to facilitate quicker reloading during the shooting stages.

Rain or shine we will be shooting for about 3 hours outdoors, so be prepared and dress accordingly. We also suggest having long sleeves, long pants and bug spray available.

NO LIVE AMMO is allowed in the class room.
