THE TOWNSHIP OF GANGES IS SEEKING PERSONS INTERESTED IN SITTING ON THE TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION and ZONING BOARD

Effective July 31, 2018, there will be a position open on The Ganges Township Planning Commission.

Candidates must be qualified township electors owning property within the Township. Planning Commission members are appointed by the Supervisor with Township Board Member approval.

Terms of service are for three years. Compensation is \$100.00 per Planning Commission meeting. Meetings are held as necessary, but the Commission must meet at least four times a year.

The Planning Commission functions to adopt and plan for the township's land use development. To offer recommendations to the Township Board, the Commission's duties include analysis of maps, plats, charts and descriptive and explanatory material submitted to the Commission for private land use. Additionally, the Planning Commission may consider the location of major streets, public systems, public utilities and structures; rehabilitation of blighted areas, location of public buildings.

The Township would request that the person accepting the position of Planning Commission member also accept membership on the Zoning Board of Appeals. The term of service for the Zoning Board of Appeals is 2 years. The function of the Zoning Board of Appeals is to provide reasonable restrictions on land use that conform to the overall township development plan. The Zoning Board of Appeals must have at least two meetings annually. Compensation for a Zoning Board of Appeals member is \$55.00 per meeting.
