Welcome to the Haltom Dance Department! We are looking forward to getting to know, and working closely with each and every one of you. Because you are enrolled in dance class you are a part of the HHS Dance Department at this school. Please understand that this is a privilege, and that several other students wanted to be in your shoes! By signing up for this class you are agreeing to be a part of the dance department events throughout the year. You will have ***four mandatory major performances*** throughout the year. You will be expected to attend rehearsals and performance as a part of your grade for this class.

While these expectations may seem high, please understand that you will not have daily homework like you would in an academic class; therefore, participation is heavily weighted in this class.

The Haltom Dance Department has multiple media pages. (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram.) BISD has a vision that all students will be successful in a future they create. A very real part of that future is the continued use of technology. We are encouraging everyone involved in the program to “LIKE” us on Facebook and request to join the social media groups so that they know what is happening. This also allows us another means in which we can communicate with students and families about what is going on.

We would like to remind everyone, however, that tools like Facebook and Twitter, and cell phones must be used in a responsible and appropriate fashion at all times. Remember, if you are following us on Facebook, people have access to your profiles if you friend them. Class Rules:

 - You must be inside the studio/gym before the tardy bell rings.
 - You must be in roll call 5 minutes after the tardy bell.
 3. Be prepared.
 - ALWAYS have clothes to dress out in.
 - ALWAYS have your journal, Buff Binder and writing utensil handy.
 4. Be respectful.
 - Keep your body, objects, and unkind words to yourself
 5. Participate.
 - Follow CHAMPS procedures
 - Have fun and ALWAYS give 101% effort!

Beginning of Class:

Be on time. Get dressed. Be in roll call within 5 minutes of the tardy bell.

Clap. Get dressed. Wait to be dismissed.

Locker Room Etiquette:

1. Keep your space clean!
2. You must bring a COMBINATION lock for your dance locker. No keys allowed.
3. Do not leave your stuff in front of other lockers
4. Do not bring food or drinks in the locker room.
5. If you don't want it stolen, lock it in your locker.
6. Extra lockers are not your storage space!
7. Don't make your locker a wardrobe closet.
8. Remembering YOUR own locker combination is YOUR responsibility. Memorize it!
9. Do not share your locker combination with ANYONE not even your best friends. It is a privilege that each of you receive your own locker. Do NOT share with friends.
10. Watch your language in the locker room, you are still in class. If you wouldn't say it in front of the teacher, don't say it in the locker room either!
11. The only time that you are allowed in to the locker room is at the beginning and end of your class period. Do not come and ask me to open the locker room during another class period, for any reason. If you might need something from the locker room during the day, bring it with you when you leave class!
12. No phones are allowed in the locker room or the restroom.

Performances are to be taken seriously. It is a time to show the community and your friends and family the hard work that you have put in to your dancing. Performance opportunities are a part of your curriculum and are necessary for the learning experience.

They are mandatory. No exceptions.

YOU MUST BE ACADEMICALLY PASSING ALL CLASSES IN ORDER TO PARTICIAPTE IN THE SHOW. IF YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND THE SHOWS AND COMPLETE ALTERNATE ASSIGNMENTS.

Class Attire:

- Tops
 - o Must be a very fitted tank top, shirt, or leotard.
 - o Men: Well-fitting shirt.
 - o Prefer black or dark color
- Bottoms
 - o Hot Shorts, Jazz Pants, Nike shorts, no baggy sweat pants.
 - o Men: Shorts.
 - o Prefer black or dark color
- Feet
 - o You will purchase Twyla's which you will be required to wear in class.
 - o You may not wear pedestrian shoes in the dance room. No sneakers, flip-flops, wedges, high heels, or flats! Leave your shoes in the locker room. (Gibson's class must wear shoes to and from the locker room). You will be allowed to wear athletic shoes when we are doing hip hop.

NO jewelry except for studs in the ears and rings. NO necklaces, NO bracelets, NO dangly earrings. NO facial piercings.

Each day, you need to wear pedestrian clothes to school, and change into your dance clothes for class. Do not wear your dance clothes to your academic classes. For dance class you need to change into your dance clothes, do not put them over your school clothes.

Class Supplies:

There are so many things that you need in a dance class that you can't even think of! For your benefit we will create a "Tubby" of necessary supplies for the class. Each student will donate a different supply and be able to use supplies out of the tubby when needed.

My Tubby Supply is: _____

- Please be prepared with pencil/pen and paper on a daily basis.
- Everyone is required to pay the yearly dance department fee \$25, this includes a Dance Department T-shirt, a pair of dance shoes, one ticket to the spring show, and various items/expenses that occur throughout the year. We wear our shirts weekly. Our Dance Department T-shirt day is Tuesday!

Grading:

Grades in dance are mostly based off of participation. There is very little written work, therefore your level of participation and amount of effort on a daily basis in class will dictate your grade. Each six weeks you will have a minimum of eight daily grades and three test grades.

50% Weekly Participation Grades (daily grade):

- Each day you will be able to earn up to 20 points, totaling 100 points for the week.
- You will earn your points by dressing out and participating.
- If you do not dress out in the required clothing you will not be able to earn your points for the day.
- Other reasons for losing points include: tardies, talking, poor attitudes, lack of effort, distracting others, breaking classroom rules, and being absent from class.
- Other activities may be used for daily grades.

Make up work (for absences only):

- When you are absent from class you will not receive the points for that day.
- You will need to complete a makeup assignment, determined by the teacher, within one week of your absence to receive the points.
- Test grades come from performances, dress rehearsals, movement tests in class and vocabulary.

The Dance Department Directors and Officers will be hosting several different social events that every dance student is encouraged to attend. These events are fun and allow you to get to know the other 300+ students taking dance and allows us to bond as a department.
