

### **NOTICE OUR BYLAW CHANGES FOR AUXILIARY**

Under Nominations and Elections changes were cosmetic Section numbers were put in order. Under Auxiliary Membership, changes were Application fee was changed from \$26.00 to \$20.00 Re-enrollment fee changed from \$26.00 to \$10.00 Under Funds, Dues instead of having three funds, Benefit, Social and General changed to just two Benefit and General.

Duel Member dues changed from \$20.00 to \$10.00 per year.

Auxiliary members will be dropped if they owe one month or by the 1st of July.

Membership Tribute, On death of member, changed from \$50.00 to \$70.00 for floral tribute or donation of their choice.

On hospitalized member for at least 2 days changed from \$50.00 to \$70.00 for floral arrangement.

Secretaries per capita is based on members in good standing and not more than one month in arrears at the end of each month. Must comply with Section 13.14 of Grand Auxiliary Rules and Regulations.

Madam Auditor shall receive \$100.00 instead of \$75.00 for faithful performance or her duties.

On travel mileage to and from Conventions, Schools and State, Regional or Provincial Convention changed from set price to: not to exceed the IRS yearly allowed amount that can be claimed, as it changes every year.

Under Miscellaneous changes were cosmetic, Section numbers were numbered correctly.
