## Prayer/ Evangelism Christian Education / Discipleship Reentry

Section I: Prayer

We instruct young Christians in the importance of personal prayer in a class called Principles of Prayer.

We also have the same emphasis concerning intercessory prayer. The class is called Principles of Intercession and the students attend both the class and one or more of the four prayer meetings each week.

Section II: Evangelism

In the area of Evangelism we do our best to follow the leading of the Holy Spirit to create opportunities in our services for individuals to be Converted, Baptized in water, Baptized in the Holy Spirit, experience Deliverance, and experience Divine Healing through anointed Preaching and Teaching.

Section III: Christian Education & Discipleship

In obedience to The Great Commission of our Lord Jesus Christ we offer intensive Christian Education /Discipleship in a format provided through various Christian Curriculums under the banner of Liberty Theological Seminaries International.

In the year 2012 we had two semesters at Bullock Correctional Facility.

We are working with The Source of Hope Reentry Transition Center located in Macon County near the town of Notasulga. The address: The Source of Hope Inc., HWY 52, Notasulga, AL. ## Section V. Graduation

Our last Graduation was held on January 17, 18, 2013 for the Academic year January – December 2012. We had Twenty – Seven (27) inmates Graduate with various Diplomas and Degrees through Liberty Theological Seminaries International of Montgomery Alabama.

Our success rate continues to remain in a high percentage of those inmates who have graduated with a diploma or degree and not returned to prison. (Approximately 89% - 90% Success Rate-See APM Tri-Fold Brochure).


