DESCRIPTION: RARE high-end target bow from 1960. Many vintage archery experts consider the 1960 American Amarco to be the best bow produced in 1960—regardless of make or model. This is a long (68") full recurve in a heavier (44#) draw weight. The bow specs were stamped into the riser. Zebrawood, Walnut and Maple riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Double-sided overlay tips (these tip overlays were an aftermarket addition). Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The decal is a reproduction. This bow sold for \$75 in 1960 (same price as the 60 Pearson Palomino), which translates to \$656 in 2021 inflation adjusted dollars.
