Speaking with 70ngues

The fifth in a series on the Gifts of the Spirit

A MONG THE Gifts of the Spirit enumerated in First Corinthians chapter twelve, three of them are Vocal gifts, or gifts of utterance. They are (1) the Gift of divers kinds of Tongues, or different kinds of languages, (2) the Gift of Interpretation of Tongues, and (3) the Gift of Prophecy.

Each one of these Gifts is wholly supernatural and it is the Spirit who gives the utterance in each manifestation.

On the day of Pentecost when the Holy Spirit was given to the tarrying disciples, we are told that,"... they were all filled with the Holy Ghost and began to speak with other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance." Here we are told that the disciples did the speaking but that the Holy Ghost gave the utterance. In other words, the Disciples yielded their tongues and their vocal organs and the Holy Spirit used them to utter languages unknown to them.

Following are some of the scripturally declared purposes of speaking with Tongues.

1. Speaking with tongues is the scriptural evidence of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit.

(a) First, let us have the testimony of Jesus on the subject. Jesus said that speaking with new tongues was to one of the signe that should follow believers. Mark 16:17. New tongues mean new languages as in Acts 2:4 and 1 Cor. 12:10. Jesus also emphatically declared that, ". . . when the Comforter is come He shall testify of me." John 15:26

Jesus again tells us that when the Holy Spirit is come, "He shall speak."

(b) Let us see what Peter had to say about speaking with tongues being the evxidence of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit. The disciples were sitting in a house when they received the Holy Spirit and began to speak as the Spirit gave them utterance. They did not remain in the house but went outside after they received the Holy Spirit. The strange phenominon of unlearned Jews speaking in many different languages drew a large crowd together. There were at Jerusalem at this time many devout Jews and proselytes of the Jewish religion from seventeen different coun'ries who heard the disciples speak in their own languages the wonderful works of God. They were amazed and perplexed and asked, " . . . What meaneth this?" "This what?" someone may ask. This speaking with tongues the context shows. Peter wasn't slow to answer. He said, "This is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel . . ." Joel predicted the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Jesus before His ascension referred to this same outpouring when He said, "For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence." The outpouring prophesied by Joel is identical with the Baptism with the Holy Spirit. Peter said "this"-(speaking with tongues) -- "is that" -- (an integral part of) -- "which was spoken by the prophet Joel." One cannot separate "this" from "that". If one has that which was spoken with tongues. Peter clearly tells us that speaking with tongues is part of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit.

(c) It is said in the scriptures, "In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established."

2 Cor. 13:1; Deut. 19:15. We have given the testimony of two reliable witnesses who positively declare that speaking with other tongues accompanies the baptism with the Holy Spirit. Now we wish to add another

witness that of the experience of the household of Cornelius when they receivel the gift of the Holy Spirit. Acts 10:44-48. Peter knew that they had received the gift of the Holy Spirit, "...For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God." No other evidence would have convinced Peter because he knew that "this is that" Acts 2:11-16.

2. Speaking with tongues is a sign to unbelievers. I Cor. 14:22. No greater example of tongues as a sign to unbelivers can be found anywhere than occured on the day of Pentecost when the disciples spoke with other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. The disciples did not address the vast multitude directly as they spoke in other languages. They began to speak with tongues before the multitude came together. Acts 2:1-6. They were immersed in the Spirit's power. Joy and glory filled their souls and they spoke in the languages of those present about the wonderful works of God.

There are two things to remember about that multitude. They believed in God, they were devout Jews but so far as Jesus was concerned they were unbelievers. They were also a bilingual people. They knew the languages of the countries where they lived and they also knew the Jewish language. When they asked, "What meaneth this?", Peter preached to them in the Aramaic language which was the language the Jews used at that time and the multitude understood him. The sign of tongues plus the preaching of Peter under the influence and power of the Holy Spirit caused about three thousand of those unbelievers to become believ-

3. Speaking with tongues when interpreted edifies the church (I Cor. 14:5, 12, 13) and has the same value as the spiritual gift of Prophecy.

4. By speaking in unknown tongues man may speak supernaturally to God. I Cor. 14:2.

5. One may pray in an unknown tongue, I Cor. 14:14. The Spirit helps us to pray according to the will of God. Rom. 8:25,27.

6. He that speaks in an unknown tongue edifies himself. I Cor. 14:4 To edify means to strengthen or to build up. Paul used this means of spiritual upbuilding by speaking much in tongues in his private devotions. I Cor. 14:18,19.

TRINITY OF THE GOD-HEAD

1. GOD the Father, 2. JESUS CHRIST the Son, and 3. The HOLY SPIRIT. "For there are Three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word (Jesus) and the Holy Ghost: . . . I John 5:7.

CONVICTION

(Act of God)

The moving of the Holy Spirit upon the heart of man to make man know his need of God. This work happens before conversion. " . . . he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:" John 14:8

REPENTANCE

(Act of Man)

"Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: REPENT YE, and believe the gospel." Mark 1:14-15.

"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to REPENTANCE. 2 Pet. 3:9.

"REPENT ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord." Acts 3:19

JUSTIFICATION . . CONVERSION (Act of God)

The forgiveness of sins . . . the passing from death to life . . . the recording of our names on the "Book of Life"

"Verily I say unto you, except ye be CONVERTED, and become as little children ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven." Matt. 18:3

"Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man (Jesus) is preached unto you the FORGIVENESS of sins: And by Him all that believe are Justified from all things, from which we could not be justified by the law of Moses."

Acts 13:38-39

"Therefore if any man be in Christ he is a NEW CREATURE: old things are passed away, behold, all things are become new." 2 Cor. 5:17

CONSECRATION

(Act of Man)

Consecration is a dedication . . . a surrender to God's will. Like as repentance brings forgiveness and justification; so CONSECRATION brings Sanctification.

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye Present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world, but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable, and perfect will of God." Romans 12:1-2

SANTIFICATION

(Act of God)

Sanctification, like Conversion is a definite work of God's Grace. It is the Second Definite Work of Grace.

"Wherefore Jesus also, that He might Sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered without the gate. Let us go forth therefore unto Him without the camp, bearing His reproach." Heb. 13:12-13.

"Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the CHURCH and gave himself for it; That he might Sanctify and Cleanse it with washing of the water by the word, that He might present it unto HIM-SELF a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be HOLY and without blemish. Eph. 5:25-27

"And the very God of peace Sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." I Thess.

BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

After the Christian is cleansed by Sanctification, he is ready for the choice gift of God, "The Baptism of the Holy Spirit". This is not Water Baptism. This is the experience the Apostolic Christians enjoyed on the day of Pentecost as recorded in Acts chapter two. The speaking in tongues (languages) is the initial evidence of the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

"John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: He shall Baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire." Luke 3:16

Jesus said, "For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence." Acts 1:5

"And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance." Acts 2:4.

"And they of the circumsion which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the Holy Ghost. For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God." Acts 10:45-46.

"For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call." Acts 2:39

THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT

In First Corinthians, chapter twelve, nine manifestations or gifts of the Holy Spirit are listed. All these gifts are miraculous and supernatural in their origin and nature. These gifts are given by the Holy Spirit to operate through Spirit-Filled Saints as God sees fit.

"For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; to another Faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues; But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will."

DIVINE HEALING

Youth Asks

IS IT IMPORTANT TO TELL OTHERS WHAT CHRIST HAS DONE FOR ME?

Your decision is important to others. Your influence affects others. Your life, as a Christian is to bear witness to Christ. Witness means: that which furnishes evidence to anything. Your life, in other words, is to be the outliving of the indwelling Christ.

But the question is: "Is it important I tell others what Christ has done for me?"

I think I'll let you answer that. But, before you do, consider this:

Christ died for you. Today, He lives for you. Surely, you want to live for Him, don't you? This thought is conveyed in II Cor. 5:14-15. The love of Christ (which He showed to you in His dying for you and His entering into your heart) should urge you to live no longer for yourself, but completely for Christ!

You reply, "Yes, but I'm too timid to talk to someone about my Master." If that's true, focus your attention on this passage of Scripture: II Tim. 1:6-8. The writer informs us that the Spirit God has given us does not impart fear and timidity, but love and power, and a sound mind.

In other words, the Holy Spirit (if you open your heart to Him, yield to Him, and are filled with Him) will give you a calm, well balanced mind. He will cause you to be self-controlled and poised. He will give you power instead of weakness and love instead of an empty feeling toward others and toward Christ.

You will be poised—not timid! You will have power—not cowardice! You will love—not fear!

So "Stir unto flame" the "ability" God has given you (v. 6), and be not ashamed of the testimony of Christ (v. 8)!

Have you answered the question yet? Another passage of Scripture may help you.

I Pet. 3:15 instructs you to make a special place in your life for God. Thus, you will be ready and prepared to give an answer to the one who might ask you about your Christian experience.

Still confused? Consider Rev. 22:17. Jesus tells us that the Holy Spirit and the Church are inviting the sinner to come to Him. He also says, "Let him that heareth say, Come." Here's the answer, isn't it? If you are a Christian (having heard the Gospel of Christ and accepting Christ) you, too, should have a part in inviting others to Christ!

In making a decision about when to start witnessing, answer the following questions:

- 1. How did I hear about Christ?
- 2. If no one had told me about Christ, would I be saved today?

Think About It

If I knew a friend of mine in danger, would I be true to him if I failed to warn him even though he didn't understand or heed the warning at the time?

Many times the cause is hindered rather than helped by the enacting of wrong laws, promoted for vicious and selfish interests.

While all this is going on, national and international troubles mount. Taxation with seemingly no reason or ceiling continues to mount. Broken treaties between nations become a

All of this may be found more or less in the restless fearful soul of men of our day, that as a whole are in the religious straits. On one hand there is a form that denies the power of God, from such we are commanded to turn away. On the other hand are those that are unbalanced and driven by a wild passion, seeking to glorify God, only to terminate in fleshly rule. JUVENILE PROBLEM FACTS

Eighty percent of High School students do not go to church. Ninety percent of College students do not go to church. Eight out of ten forsake church attendance upon entering the teen age. Church attendance was the hightest in percent in America in 1882 and is at its lowest today. During 1957, 53% of all arrests for the major offenses against property were persons under 18 years of age. More than two-thirds of the auto?theft arrests and over half of the burglary and larceny arrests involved juveniles. In the past eight years juvenile arrests have increased 55% against the juvenile population increase of 22%. All of this can lead to a dark age and the death of this present civilization.

SOME ARE READY

I have written to you about a world in general that has forgotton God, but we must remember that there are a few that have kept their garments and that have lived with the love of God abounding in their hearts. The call to salvation has reached some—the message of real sanctification has moved the hearts of some, and still some have followed the Lamb all the way and have received the Mighty Baptism of the Holy Spirit.
