Reaching Our Goals

A hearty thank you goes to all the individuals, businesses, women's clubs, churches, foundations, and volunteers who support our program. Our ability to bless others became possible only because of your generosity. In **2016**, our amazing volunteers logged over 3,400 hours of service. A MILLION thanks!!!!

We can proudly say we reached our goals this

year and . . .

Took over **1,750** emergency and assistance calls. Fed over 100 women and kids monthly from our food bank.

Opened our Second Food Bank at Richland Hills Christian Church, administered by Jim and Patty Stager. Thanks to RHCC, our clients now have two locations for food and other needs.

Provided backpacks to over 200 kids.

Helped over **200** women and kids with emergency needs, rent, electricity, gas cards, and other bills.

Did over **800** manicures, pedicures, facials, haircuts, and massages at our I Can Still Shine Monthly events.
