Call to Order: at Jake's Junction Pub by President Bob Kaiser

Roll Call: Alliance officers present: Bob Kaiser, Jackie Olson, Kate Fuchs, Absent Steve Fausnaugh. 8 Clubs present; Absent, Rock County Snowblowers

Secretary's Report: On file in Secretary's book.

Treasurer's Report: Copies of the treasurer's report were distributed. Jackie Olson read it, a copy is on file in the secretary's book. Mark Hubka made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Rod Burzinski seconded it, motion carried.

Pay Bills: Bills were presented for payment. Scott Johnson made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Rod Burzinski seconded it, motion carried. Discussion was held on our financial situation for the next few months and what bills we need to pay. We need to leave about \$6,000 for insurance as well as money for other expenses. Levi has a bill for the county for about \$6500. Levi Olson made a motion to pay \$23,000 principal on the groomer. Mark Hubka seconded it, motion carried.

Directors Report: A survey was sent out via e-mail and responses were requested to be returned by 5/4. ISC will be held in Nova Scotia and Rod will be attending again this year. The summer directors' meeting will be held July 14th in DeForest, WI. Workshop will be held 10/26-10/28 at the Chula Vista.

Trail Report: After GPS'ing the trails our mileage for this year was calculated to be 214.8 miles, we had previously thought we had 226.8 miles. This will equal out to our grant being approximately \$64,440 for next year. Trail take out will be about \$6453, we are getting paid more for labor and for equipment, so that is helping. We have about 3 bridges that need to be redocked. Road signs will be updated this year by the county, currently we have about 40 pairs of signs, this will be decrease to about 25 pairs of signs. We have approximately \$16,700 left available in the grant, if anyone has more signs, bridge repairs, etc. please let Levi know.

President's Report: Thanks to everyone and we hope to keep on moving forward. After 10+ years of service as President, Bob will not be running for office next year. Thank you, Bob, for your years of service. Please consider volunteering for the position, we need more infusion of new talent and ideas!

Groomer Report: The West groomer will be housed at a new location, Ferger sold his business. Dave Graves, by Potters Road off Hwy 11 said that it is ok to keep the groomer stored there over the summer and hopes to become more involved mechanically with help for the West groomer. Both the South and North groomers were all set for summer.

Youth Advisor Report: Lynsey will be attending the ISC in June, still looking for ideas for a campground for the summer KAOS camping trip.

Old Business: We need to get map ads sold ASAP. We can upgrade ads to be in color. Brian Gray will be updating the map and latest ads can be turned in is September's meeting. Nothing to report on updates for the Morris Nelson Memorial.

New Business: Levi Olson made a motion to suspend meetings in June, July and August. Rod Burzinski seconded it, motion carried. Rod Burzinski is planning on attending the ISC in June, but due to costs has requested help to attend. Scott Johnson made a motion to pay \$750 to pay towards the costs that Rod incurs, Gary Stapleman seconded the motion. Motion carried. Rod appreciates the help and said Thanks!
